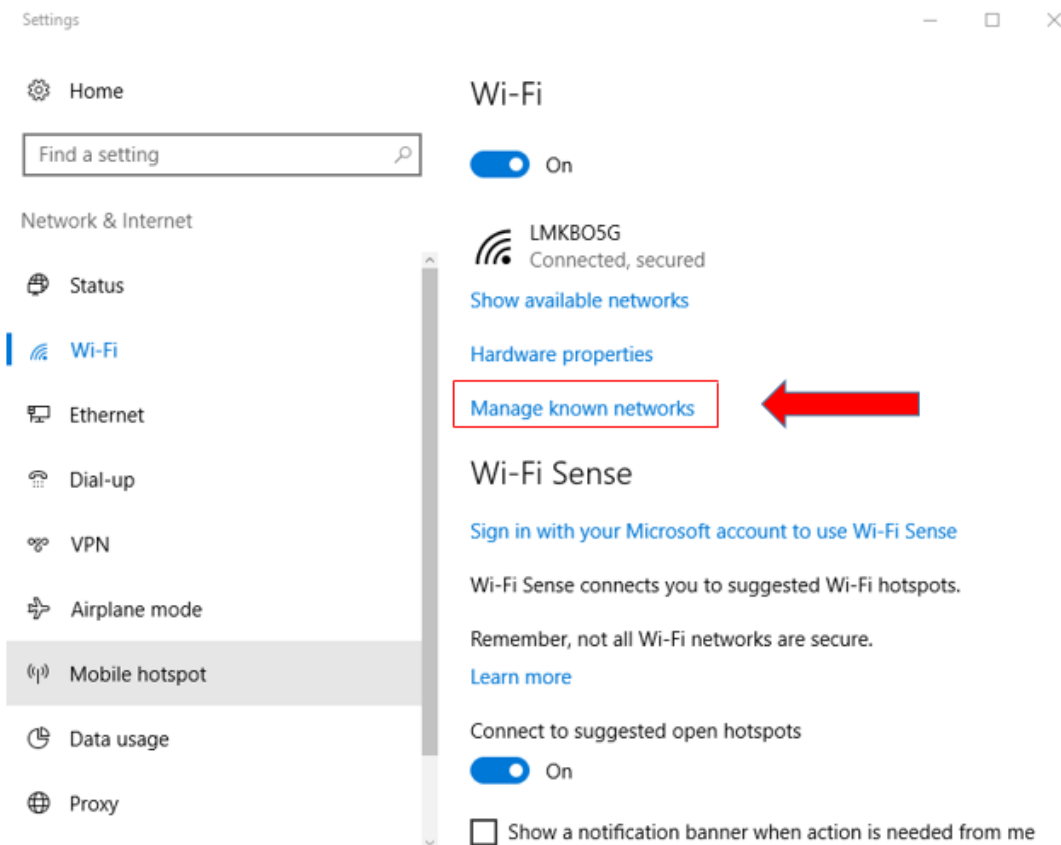


# Windows 10

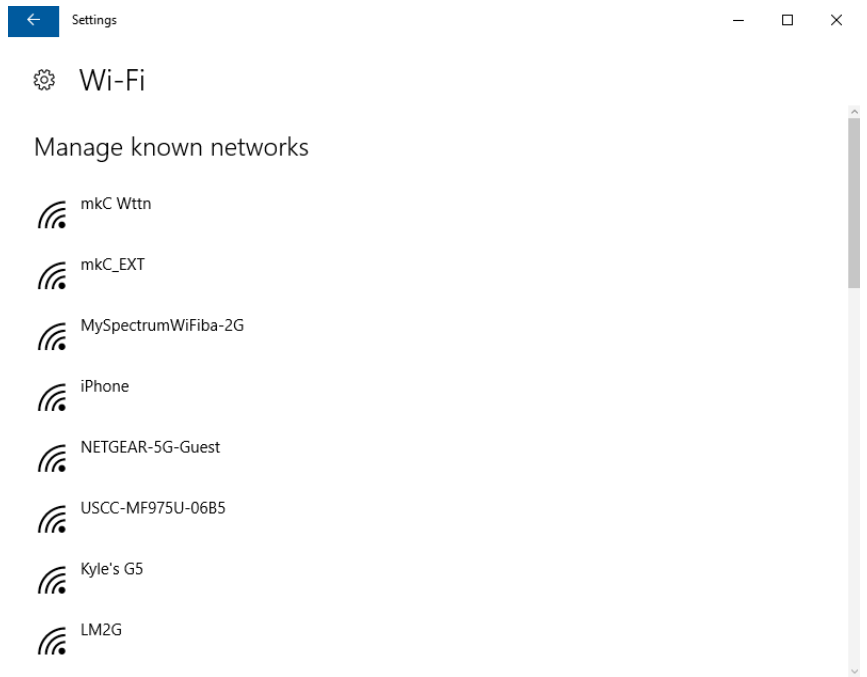
## Set a metered connection

Setting a connection as metered prevents Windows from automatically using bandwidth in many ways. It disables automatic Windows Updates, disables automatic App Updates, and stops the auto refreshing of your Windows Tiles. You can always download the Windows Updates at later time.

1. Click on your Wi-Fi connection in the taskbar on the far bottom right corner of the screen and select Network Settings at the bottom of the panel that pops up.
2. Click “Manage known networks” (third choice listed in blue font)
3. Select the Wi-Fi connection you would like to add the metered connection feature to.
4. Click “Properties”
5. Turn metered connection “On”
