

Bahamas Roaming

1. Validate that the device is not set on home only:

Android devices:

- **Samsung:** Settings> More networks > Mobile Networks> System Select> Automatic; Also ensure data roaming in on.
- **LG:** Settings> Tethering and networks (could be MORE for some new devices) > Mobile Networks> System Select> CDMA Roaming Mode> Automatic
- **Motorola:** Settings> More> Mobile Networks (could be Cellular Networks) > System Select> Automatic

Apple devices:

- **iPhone:** Setting> Cellular> Cellular Data Options> Roaming> Turn on both voice and data roaming

2. Validate that the device is set to pick up available GSM networks:

Android devices:

- **Samsung:** Settings> Mobile Networks> Network Mode > Global
- **LG:** Settings> Tethering and networks (could be MORE for some new devices) > Mobile Networks> System Select> Global
- **Motorola:** Settings> More> Mobile Networks> Preferred network Type> Global

Apple Devices

- **iPhone:** Settings> Cellular>Cellular Data Options> Roaming > International CDMA> Turn International CDMA off
 - *International CDMA > On: iPhone will attempt to use an available CDMA network instead of GSM.*
 - *International CDMA > Off: iPhone will use only GSM networks.*

3. When you return to your home service area you'll need to return your network mode back to LTE/CDMA

Android devices:

- **Samsung:** Settings> Mobile Networks> Network Mode > LTE/CDMA
- **LG:** Settings> Tethering and networks (could be MORE for some new devices) > Mobile Networks> System Select> LTE/CDMA
- **Motorola:** Settings> More> Mobile Networks> Preferred network Type> LTE/CDMA

Apple devices:

- **iPhone:** Settings> Cellular> Roaming > International CDMA> Turn International CDMA [On](#)
 - *International CDMA > On: iPhone will attempt to use an available CDMA network instead of GSM.*
 - *International CDMA > Off: iPhone will use only GSM networks*

How to Dial When Roaming Internationally (outside the U.S.)

1. Making a phone call while traveling internationally:

- Dial Plus Sign (+), then the country code, then the ten digit U.S. number
- ***To enter the plus sign (+), press and hold "0" on the keypad until the "+" appears on your screen***

2. Calling U.S. Cellular Customer Care while traveling internationally:

- Dial Plus Sign (+), then 1, then the ten digit U.S. number
- Example: +1-865-777-8484
